Teaching Internship Details

- Program length is 2 months from mid June to mid August
- Applications are considered on a rolling basis. Early applicants are encouraged and are given first consideration.

Interns will teach at the ACTS Secondary School in Bangalore, which enrolls approximately 1200 students and is accredited by the ICSE Council New Delhi. The school is committed to training up children of all socio-economic levels through quality education that will transform the whole person and equip them to face the challenges of today's varied contexts.

ACTS Secondary School has opportunities to teach the following subjects in grades 4 to 7: English, math, social studies, history, geography, general science, physics, chemistry, and biology.

Following a period of observation, interns will teach 4 to 5 periods a day (40 minutes each) in their selected field. Each intern will be assigned a state-licensed teacher mentor for the duration of the experience.

Eligibility

- Enrolled in or having completed a teacher education program
- Junior, senior, or graduate level student

- Housing accommodations near school
