ICHE's next Triennial Council will be conducted in the beautiful village of Beatenberg in Switzerland.

Location

Beatenberg is located high above Lake Thun and is a sun terrace that offers a breathtaking panorama of some famous Swiss Alpine peaks. It is about 10 kms from Interlaken. Being away from the main tourist routes, the village provides an ideal setting for our gathering in June 2010.



Program
